Subject: MACSIS and MITS Claims Processing in State Fiscal Year 2013

The purpose of this communication is to thank you for your participation in the February 16 discussion, provide a meeting summary and request your assistance with identifying persons that are able to participate in upcoming work activity critical to moving this project forward in a timely manner.

As indicated in the ODMH/ODADAS February 3, 2012 communication and validated during the February 16 conversation, there is significant work that needs to be accomplished in a relatively short period of time. This work will proceed as follows:

- ODMH/ODADAS will be convening several small groups to have targeted discussions in the following areas: software requirements for 837/835; Board access to data; electronic data interface (EDI) standards for third party liability (TPL); retrospective Medicaid eligibility; Medicaid spend down; batch eligibility; new client enrollment; parallel MACSIS changes; provider training; and SFY 12 Medicaid claims run-out.
- A brief description of these targeted discussion areas is attached. These meetings will be scheduled during the week of February 27, 2012. Face-to-face attendance is encouraged; however bridge lines will be available.
